COUNTY TAX RATES AND LEVIES

A Resolution accepting the amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission and authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them to the County Auditor, and declaring an emergency was presented for adoption. Sam Wiley made a motion, seconded by Sue Rogers, to suspend the rules. Motion carried with no discussion. Sam Wiley made a motion, seconded by Sue Rogers, to adopt Resolution 2020-34 by title only. Bob asked what the legislation was for, and Bonnie explained that every year the County Budget Commission meets to determine the rates and amounts of funds that are received from the State and distributed to the County's local governments. It also authorizes the County Auditor to distribute our share of the property taxes to us, and without the legislation we would not receive these funds. Motion carried with no further discussion.

There being no further business on the agenda, Sue Rogers made a motion, seconded by Sam Wiley, to adjourn. Motion carried with no discussion. The meeting adjourned at 6:02pm.
