

The Shade Tree Commission for the Village of Monroeville had a regular meeting, April 15, 2026 at 6 PM at Marsh Field.

Present: Sue Long, Marie Bischoff, Karen Wanger, Eric Bischoff. And guest Ken Underwood.

Election of Officers: Marie Bischoff will be Chairman and Sue Long will be Secretary.

Arbor Day was discussed. A Red Maple tree will be planted at March Field in honor of Arbor Day. The ceremony will be April 29, 2026, at 6 PM. Sue will invite the mayor to read the Proclamation and order the tree.

Sue noted the Village is once again a Tree USA village for 2025.

Ken Underwood said he was there to see what the Shade Tree Commission was all about. He asked if there were plans to plant trees in the boulevards at Eagle View. It was decided we would contact Tom Gray, the Village Administrator, to help plan where to plant trees since all utilities are underground.

Eric mentioned a tree in front of his residence is dying. He would like another tree when that one is removed.

The planters uptown were discussed. There are only 5 so 4 will be put on the corners uptown and the other one will be placed in front of the Municipal building. Sue suggested we do a red, white and blue color scheme since it is the 250 birthdays for the country. The flowers we hope to plant are purple salvia, red geraniums and dusty rose.
